As part of Accedian's partnership with Cisco, Skylight has been integrated with Cisco NSO and Crosswork Network Controller (CNC) to allow service assurance automation. This automation enables service assurance capabilities to be rolled out and managed in parallel with the service transport, providing continuous, comprehensive visibility and deep granular insights into the quality of the service (QoS) being delivered. This can also enable the automation layer to take remedial actions when a service is impacted by degradations or issues affecting network quality. Additionally, the Skylight integration with CNC provides an automated assurance layer with service-based intelligence to facilitate the transition towards an intent-based model.

The integration enables customers to control deployment and service launch costs and achieve efficiencies across multiple departments.


